Readers enjoy our picture books in many ways. We are passionate about creating reading experiences related with our books.

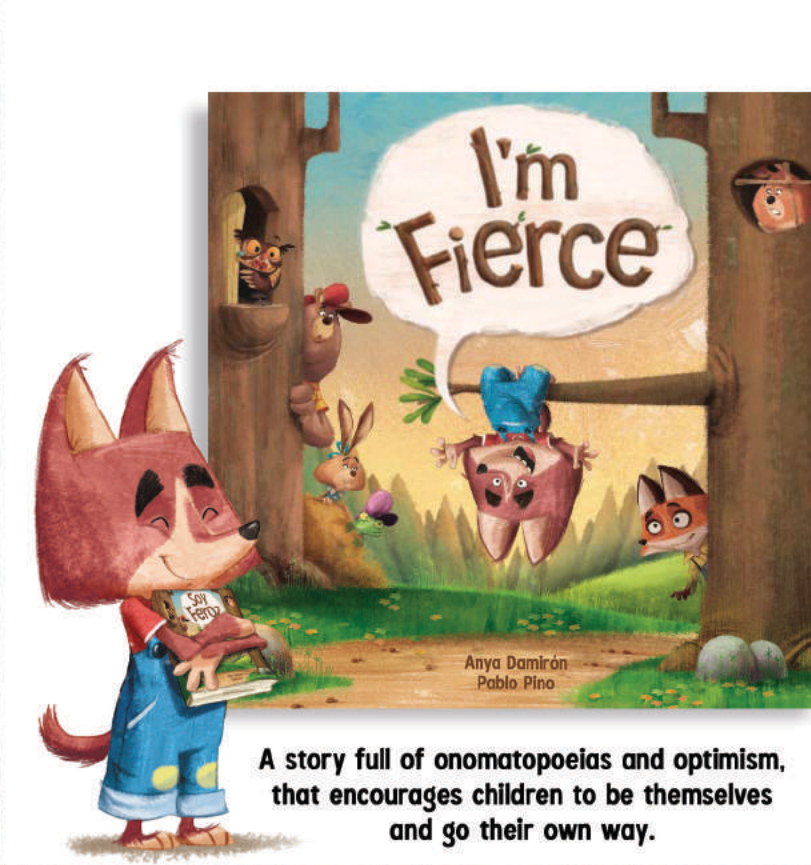

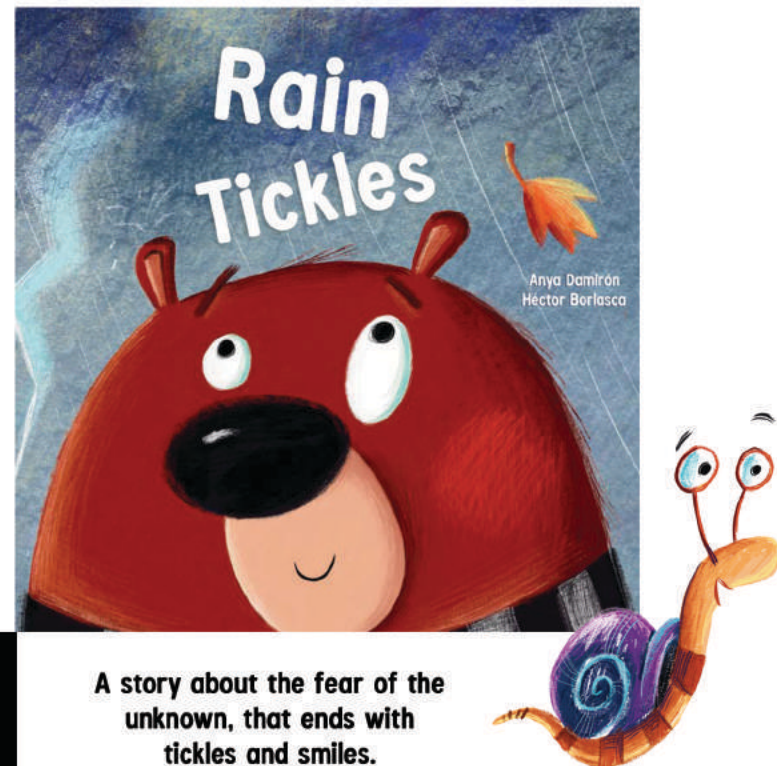


At a certain point in childhood

A story about optimism, in a city full of animals, with action, icecream, skaters, and many accidents, that invites us to share in community.

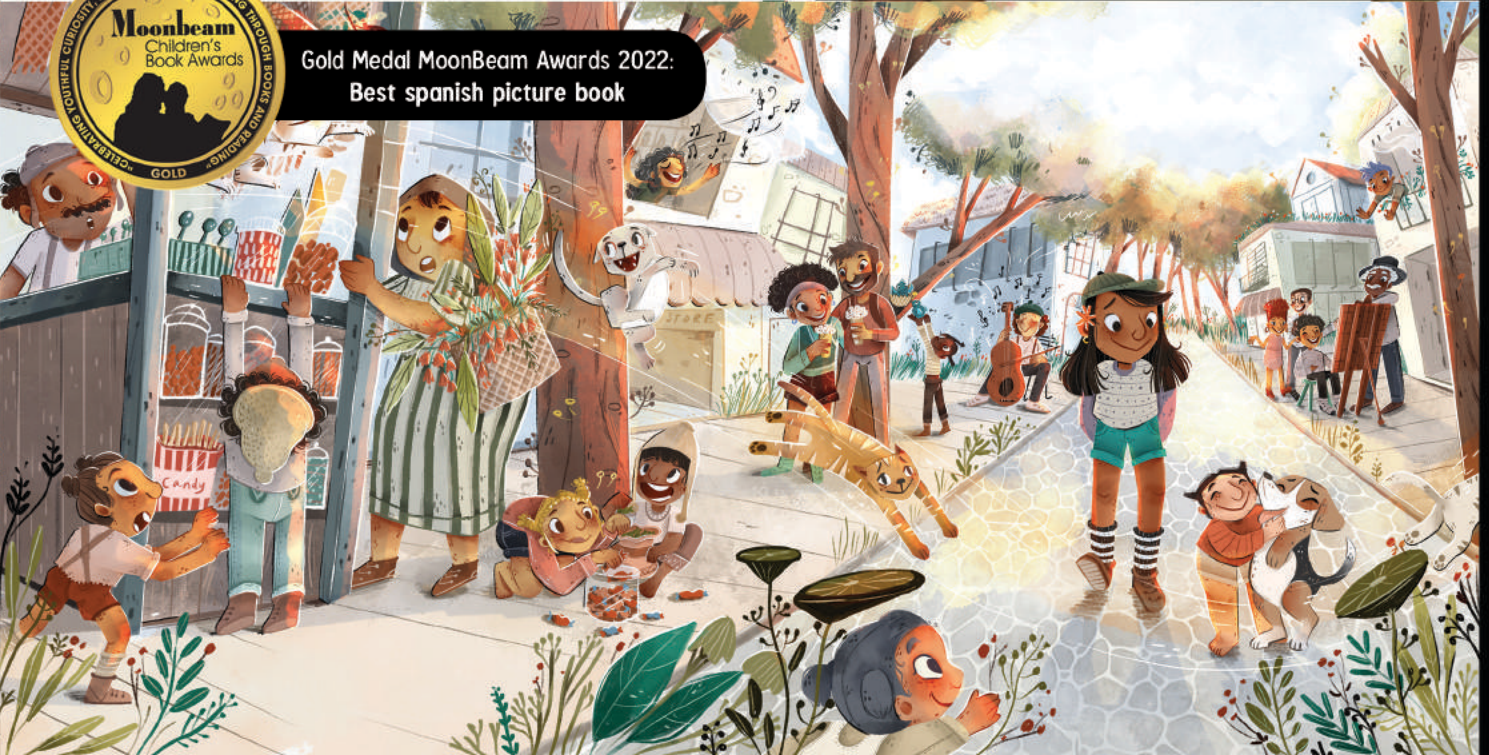
Clio is curious, dreamy, very distracted and a little clumsy, but above all she is optimistic.

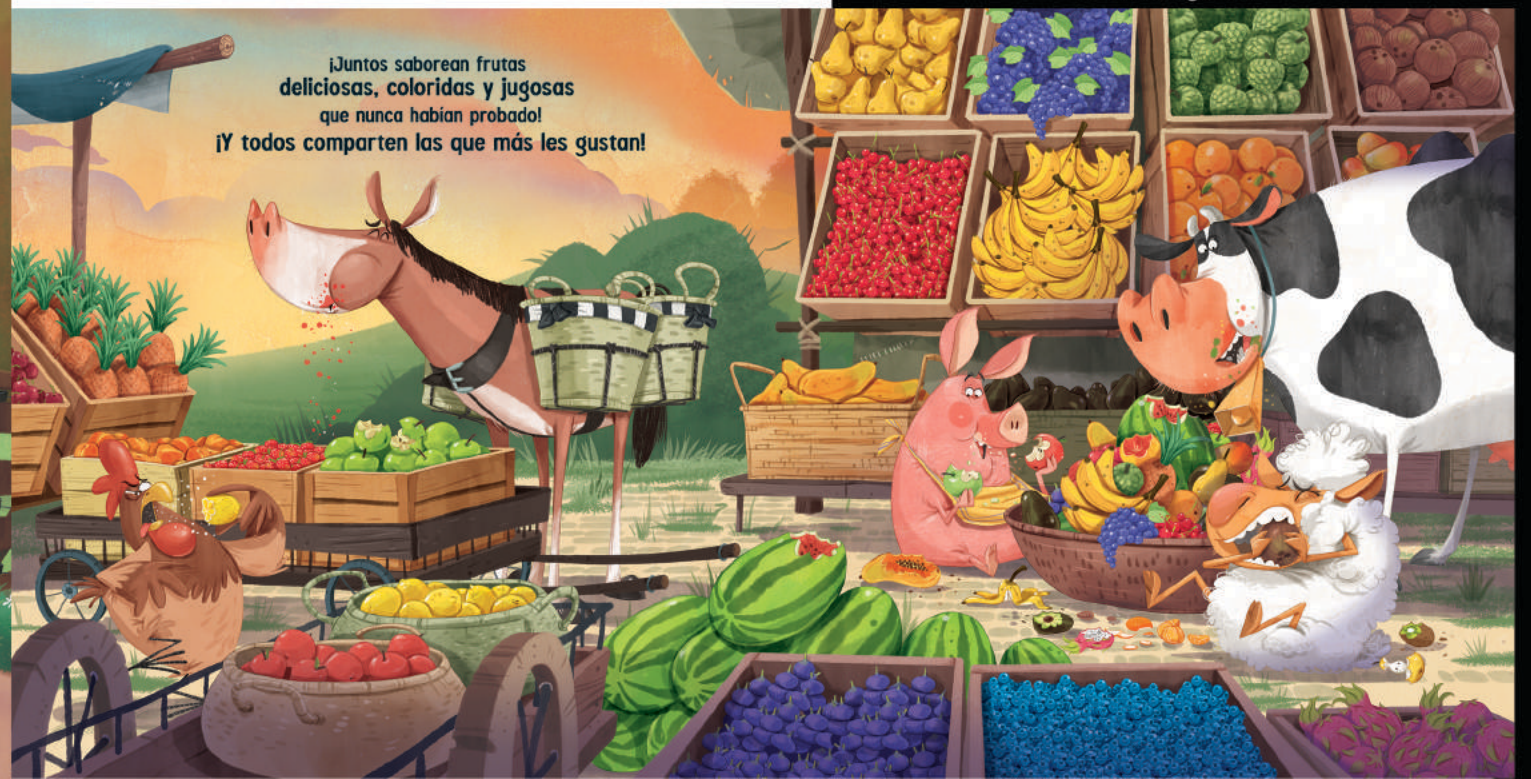
This is a cumulative story, with farm animals and a song, created to catch the attention of the little ones.

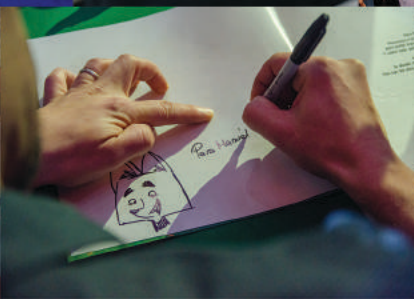




Gracia Iglesias
